



3.50.063-AD Physical Examination

All students who participate in practice and/or competition in the interscholastic athletic program shall have a physical examination by a physician possessing an unrestricted license to practice medicine, a licensed physician assistant, a certified nurse practitioner or a licensed chiropractic physician.

- (1) The “professional” (as listed above) must verify the ability of the student to participate.
- (2) Students in grades 7 through 12 are required to have physical examinations performed prior to participation in extracurricular sports. “Participation,” as used in this policy means participation in sports practices and interscholastic sports competition.
- (3) Verifying cards signed by the “professional” must be on file in the school office. Cards may be obtained at school.
- (4) In case of a diagnosis of a significant illness or injury, or a major surgery of a student athlete, an additional physical examination with verification of the ability of the student to participate must be provided to the school.
