

he second meeting of the Design Advisory Group DAG) focused on the organization of the school uilding on the main school site.

efore beginning the presentation, DAG members rere asked to put themselves into the mind of a igh school student. First, they were asked ref ect in their own school experience and share where hey liked to gather at their school and why. Then, he design team shared feedback from a May CHS taff meeting in response to two prompts "How o staff collaborate?" and "What do students need o take charge of their learning?" Between these wo exercises, the DAG members were able to hink about the types and qualities of spaces that upport students and staff within a high school.

fter Bruce provided an update from their recent ommunity-based listening sessions and the June Public Design Workshop. Students, workshop tendees, and the DAG #2 participants were given n opportunity to share images and words that they ink would support their vision for the new CHS. ne example of a completed collage is shown on e right.

he team shared f ve emerging design themes ased on the spatial feedback that has been ovided through the community engagement ocess: Accessibility, Wayfinding/Orientation, noice, Identity/Place Making, and Wellness/ ophilia. These themes will inf uence how chool spaces will be organized. For example, response to the comment that students need paces to pause and rest, the team is incorporating options for seating along hallways. The design of these bench areas will consider accessibility, placemaking, and wellness.





The design team shared feedback from DAG #1 and CHS Staff meeting exercises about functional adjacencies within the building (i.e. which rooms want to be near other rooms). This feedback is inf uencing the building plans, which are in development.

DAG members were asked to provide input based on images of exterior and landscape features. Their preferences will be synthesized and shared at DAG #3.

The f nal stage of the meeting was to share the current building and site organization and invite the DAG to provide feedback. The team shared diagrams that show the proposed school organized into two wings with a courtyard in the middle. This courtyard will be a secure space for students to access during the school day.
