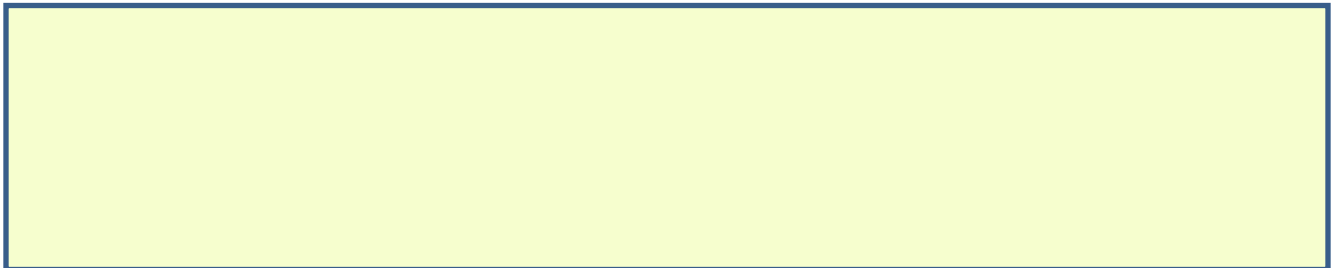


# LOTTERY INCOME ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION
