# What are safety data sheets? – *continued*

## Where do employers get safety data sheets?

Chemical manufacturers, importers, and distributors must provide safety data sheets assessing the hazards of chemicals with the SDS. SDSs may also be obtained from retailers that sell the chemical.



## What information is required on safety data sheets?

Safety data sheets must contain the following information:

- 1. Manufacturer or distributor name, address, telephone number, and email address.
- 2. Product name and identification number.
- 3. Hazard identification.
- 4. Composition information.
- 5. First aid measures.
- 6. Fire-fighting measures.
- 7. Accidental release measures.
- 8. Exposure controls/personal protection.
- 9. Physical and chemical properties.
- 10. Stability and reactivity.
- 11. Toxicological information.
- 12. Ecological information.
- 13. Disposal information.
- 14. Transport information.
- 15. Regulatory information.
- 16. Other information.
